


To our most dedicated community,



Life can unravel in seconds for a family when their child is diagnosed with a life-threatening disease, is born prematurely or has been injured, and families find themselves in varying levels of preparation.

One may have a bag packed for a planned heart surgery. Another might be in shock after a child's traumatic injury, without a change of clothes or toothbrush.

All have an urgent need to be together with their hospitalized child and they want the best medical care possible. Our Family Room programs add the extra level of security for families, however they've ended up at the hospital, to ensure they find a place of respite close to their child where they can do a load of laundry, grab a snack, take a shower, or simply step away from the commotion of a hospital room.
